

2005 Westside Zinfandel

Appellation: 100% Paso Robles

Composition: 100% Zinfandel

Vineyard Designation or Source: Old Schoolhouse/Mustang Springs/Mustard Creek

Vinification:

These estates were individually handpicked into half ton bins. At the winery, each block was carefully sorted so that only the optimum fruit was used to make each wine. The fruit from each vineyard was fermented in half ton bins and gently squeezed in traditional basket presses. Each lot was individually aged in 20-30% New American and Hungarian Oak. Prior to bottling, we selected the blend of our different vineyards. Each vineyard provides a unique flavor and aroma to this blend.

Winemaker's Notes:

This new vintage of our flagship wine has all the components of an elegant and exotic Zinfandel. It shows nice earth tones with black pepper and spice along with notes of cherries, strawberries and blueberries. This wine has a velvet texture on the palate with a bit of minerality on the finish.
