

PEACHY CANYON

2015 WESTSIDE ZINFANDEL

VINIFICATION

The 2015 Westside started with gently hand harvesting fruit from a select group of high quality vineyards on the Westside of Paso Robles. The fruit was carefully sorted and destemmed into tanks and fermented in stainless steel tanks until dry. The wine was racked to barrel and aged for 16 months in 30% new oak.

TASTING NOTES

Flush with ripe, dark fruit, and rich baking spices, the 2015 Westside is a bold and varietally true Zinfandel. The bottle opens with aromas of blackberry, clove, and a cabinet's worth of anise, allspice, nutmeg, and cocoa. On the palate, look for strawberry, huckleberry, and dessert spices like vanilla and clove. Lush fruit and supple tannins lend structure to this delectable Zin.
