VINIFICATION

The juice for this Rosé was taken from multiple estate lots at Mustang Springs Ranch. After cold settling and racking, this rose was fermented in neutral French barrels. Once dry, the rosé wine was racked off of its gross lees, blended and barreled back down to the same neutral French barrels to overwinter.

TASTING NOTES

Peach rosé pink in color, this rosé is crystal clear and smells of strawberry, guava and lychee. Bright, acidic and flavorful on the palate, this wine tastes of strawberries, peaches, nectarines and mandarin orange.
